May is almost here and we cannot wait to begin fundraising for the [Voice of the Martyrs!](#)

Throughout the month of May, the fifth grade class will be organizing and leading a fundraiser for Voice of the Martyrs, an organization that exists to serve, encourage, and support our persecuted brothers and sisters in Christ amongst some of the most unreached people groups of the world. Grade 5 will focus on the world's top three nations most affected by persecution: 1) Afghanistan, 2) North Korea, and 3) Somalia.

VOM Fundraisers and Opportunities:

- **Ice Cream Fundraisers:** One fundraising event we are particularly excited for is our **Ice Cream Fundraiser Events on May 6th, May 13th, and May 20th**. During these events, the fifth grade class will sell ice cream during lunchtime to all SSCA students and faculty/staff. **Ice cream sandwiches will be \$2 and popsicles will be \$1.**
 - **How to purchase Ice Cream:**
 - **Lower School:** Lower School students will be sent home with the ice cream order forms today, April 25th. The forms and money are to be given to your student's teacher or to the main office and are **due THIS Friday, April 29th**. *If you do not receive an order form, or need an extra one, please see the attached document for an extra order form.* Ice cream will be distributed on May 6th, May 13th, and May 20th.
 - **Upper School:** *Upper school students will not receive an ice cream order form.* Instead, Upper School students are encouraged to **bring money on May 6th, May 13th, and May 20th** if they would like to purchase ice cream.
- **Special Dress Down Day:** There will also be a Special Dress Down Day on **Friday, May 20th** for this foundation. All students can participate in this special event. Please wear loose fitting sweatpants and sweatshirts. All rules of SSCA modesty apply. *Students must NOT wear yoga pants or leggings.* Please bring in **\$2** to participate in this event.
- **Donations:** For cash or check donations, please place your loose change in the water jugs that will be located in the main hallway and in the Lower School wings throughout the month of May. For North Korea, there will also be an additional option to donate by filling out the donation forms that will be located next to the water jugs in the main hallway. In these donation forms, students will have the opportunity to write a note that will be sent with the Bibles that will be brought through the North Korean border. Please put these donation forms and notes in the box next to the water jugs located in the main hallway.
